Toni Fuscellaro made a motion to accept the minutes from the January meeting. Zach Ruffo seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Frank Basile distributed the monthly recreation newsletter to the members.

Frank Basile stated that a new bike machine has been purchased for the exercise room. Frank added that the department has been trying to get a new piece each year for the room and that perhaps new elliptical machine can be purchased for next year next year. He added that usage of the room is way up from last year. The room, as usual, will be shut down from mid June through September due to day camp and then later building maintenance. Toni Fuscellaro and Zach Ruffo both stated that the exercise room is a nice amenity for residents.

Frank Basile stated that the gymnastics/tumbling program began a new session last month. Open for ages 3-6. Smaller program than we've had in the past, with just the younger children involved.

Frank Basile discussed the junior basketball program that is ongoing for grades 3-5.

Frank Basile stated that the Island Tournament and Skills Competition is scheduled for Feb. 21-25 and that the recreation commission trust fund will need to be tapped for expenditures. Toni Fuscellaro made a motion for the approval of expenditures not to

exceed \$4000 for the Island Tournament. Zach Ruffo seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Frank Basile spoke about the Islander travel basketball program. Three teams participating in the South Shore Basketball League. Frank stated that there are a couple thousand dollars in expenditures for league fees and officials. Zach Ruffo made a motion to approve \$2300 of recreation commission funds toward the Islander basketball costs. Toni Fuscellaro seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Frank Basile said there are a few grammar school dances scheduled for this month and there will also be one in March.

Frank Basile stated that Crest Memorial has been using the Crest Pier for some of its home basketball games through January and February.

Frank Basile stated that Pier Playmates Day Camp information will be going out to families of children who were in camp last year in about a week. Frank stated that forms were held to wait for rate changes to take effect by ordinance.

Toni Fuscellaro asked about grades K-2 indoor soccer registration. Frank said a handful have come in but that registration just opened. He said he's confident enough kids will register to have a healthy league. Toni said she hears around town that the kids and parents love the league.
