Wildwood Crest Spring Beach Sweep April 13, Paper Shredding Event April 14

WILDWOOD CREST – The Wildwood Crest Department of Public Works, in conjunction with Clean Ocean Action/NJ Clean Communities, will host a Beach Sweep event on Saturday, April 13, from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., staged from Centennial Park.

The borough will also host a paper-shredding service for borough residents on Sunday, April 14, from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., also at Centennial Park. An industrial-sized paper shredder will be available for borough residents. A current Wildwood Crest recycling permit is required to use the paper shredder. The April 13 Beach Sweep event will be held rain or shine and will adhere to all current state and local CDC guidelines.

Volunteers must register in advance. Volunteers will be required to sign a waiver and agree to follow all safety guidelines. Please follow the link below to register:

Volunteers of all ages are needed for the Beach Sweep. Participants collect, remove and record valuable data about debris, which is presented in annual reports and used to advance federal, state and local programs to reduce litter on New Jersey beaches and waterways.

Registered volunteers should check in at Centennial Park, located at Fern Road and Ocean Avenue, on the day of the event. Volunteers should wear weather appropriate clothing and are asked to bring their own gloves, water, hand sanitizer and snacks. Volunteers are also encouraged to bring their own buckets to reduce plastic bag use.

Participants who are members of the Wildwood Crest Adopt-A-Beach program will receive credit for one clean.

This Beach Sweep will be extremely helpful to the borough's already intensive efforts to keep its vast expanse of beaches clean.
