### THE BOROUGH OF WILDWOOD CREST BEGINS SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

On April 1, 2013, the Borough of Wildwood Crest, in conjunction with the County of Cape May, will institute a new recycling collection process called *Single Stream Recycling*. This process allows residents and businesses of the borough to now place previously separated recyclable materials into one container. For residential customers, the red and yellow containers will continue to be used for your recycling needs. Commercial, hotel, and motel customers may now place previously separated recyclable materials into the same commercial size dumpster. Remember to read the list of items on this page that are allowable recyclable materials. Also, the Special Points of Interest Section on the bottom of this page notes items that cannot be recycled. Please place these items in your regular trash. All Recyclable Materials May Now Be Placed In The Same Container

### SINGLE STREAM RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

#### PAPER

- Newspaper with Inserts • Office Paper
- Junk Mail • Brown Paper Bags • Magazines
- Shredded Paper (*in a clear plastic bag*)
- Telephone and Paperback Books • Cardboard
- CLEAN Pizza Boxes • Gift and Shoe Boxes
- Tissue and Powdered Detergent Boxes
- Beer Carriers • Soda Carriers
- Non-Foil Wrapping Papers
- Dry Food Boxes (*Cereal, Cracker, Pasta, etc.*)  
(*Remove all liner bags*)

#### PLASTIC

- #1 through #7 Plastic Bottles and Containers Including:
  - Food and Beverage Containers (*Margarine Tubs, Microwave Trays, Yogurt Containers, etc.*)
  - Health, Beauty, and Cleaning Product Containers
  - Other Rigid Plastic Containers Including Buckets (*5 gallons in size or less*)
  - Landscape Pots (*5 gallons in size or less*)

#### GLASS CONTAINERS

- Clear and Green
- Brown Bottles, Jars, and Jugs

#### METAL

- Food, Beverage, and Aerosol Cans:
  - Aluminum
  - Steel (Tin)(*5 gallons in size or less*)

### SPECIAL POINTS OF INTEREST

#### \* DO NOT RECYCLE \*

- Food Contaminated Boxes, Plastic Bags, Paint Cans
- Styrofoam Packaging, Polystyrene Egg Cartons
- Wax Coated Cardboard Boxes, Beverage Cups
- Window Glass, Light Bulbs
- Items That Contained Chemicals or Hazardous Products

Curbside and commercial recycling schedules will not change. Continue to place your recycling materials out for pickup on your regularly scheduled pickup days. Schedules can be picked up at Borough Hall, Public Works, or online at:

The Borough of Wildwood Crest strongly encourages the use of the red and yellow recycling containers. This allows the sanitation workers to easily identify the materials set out for pickup. If needed, additional containers may be picked up at the Public Works Department. Larger containers are allowed if labeled on the exterior with the words "Single Stream Recycling". The two large green recycling containers at the Public Works yard will now be used for single stream recycling.

# OTHER ITEMS....

## **WE DO NOT ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FOR PICK-UP OR DROP-OFF:**

- **Paint/Cans with paint inside**
- **Tires**
- **Fire Extinguishers or Propane Tanks**
- **Concrete**
- **Hazardous Waste (gasoline, antifreeze, lawn chemicals, pool chemicals, asbestos)**
- **Dirt or Soil**
- **Tree Stumps or Root Systems**

1) **RIGID PLASTICS:** Plastic toys, lawn furniture, coolers, shelving, totes, flower pots, are **NOT** regular recycling items. Residents must call the Public Works Department for pick-up – (609) 522-7446

## 2) **BULKY WASTE, SCRAP METAL AND APPLIANCES:**

- MUST CALL FOR PICK-UP**, Public Works Department – (609) 522-7446
- OR DROP-OFF**, (LOCATED ON BAYVIEW DRIVE BETWEEN NEWARK AVE & JEFERSON AVE)
  - October through April: Monday – Friday, 7am-2pm; Saturday-Sunday, 3pm-5pm
  - May through September: Monday-Thursday, 7am-2pm; Friday-Sun, 3pm-5pm

## 3) **TREE BRANCHES & LIMBS, VEGETATIVE WASTE, LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, ELECTRONICS:**

- MUST CALL FOR PICK-UP**, Public Works Department – (609) 522-7446 (no dirt, soil, or stumps. Branches tied in bundles; clippings in brown vegetative bags; electronics must be visibly in-tact)
- OR DROP-OFF**, (LOCATED ON BAYVIEW DRIVE BETWEEN NEWARK AVE & JEFERSON AVE.-no dirt, soil, or stumps)
  - October through April: Monday – Friday, 7am-2pm; Saturday-Sunday, 3pm-5pm
  - May through September: Monday-Thursday, 7am-2pm; Friday-Sun, 3pm-5pm
