WHEREAS, the Borough of Wildwood Crest requires the professional services of an architectural firm specializing in Exterior Improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to employ a professional, pursuant to law, who is duly trained, experienced and specialized in the area of custom architectural design, zoning analysis, diagrams, design and construction documentation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wildwood Crest has a Review Committee consisting of the Borough Administrator, Constance Mahon; Borough Clerk, Patricia Feketics; Chief Financial Officer, Francine Springer; and Borough Solicitor, Ronald J. Gelzunas; and

WHEREAS, the Review Committee has reviewed the proposal submitted by William McLees dated May 13, 2019 and has recommended that the proposal of William McLees best meets the Borough’s needs and that William McLees has the professional credentials and abilities to perform the services required of the subject contract; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that William McLees, AIA, of the firm of William McLees Architecture, 5 MacArthur Boulevard, Somers Point, New Jersey is qualified to perform said work and it is desired to enter a professional contract with William McLees for said services pursuant to law, and to provide for the advertising of a notice pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Borough of Wildwood Crest concur with the Review Committee’s recommendation to award the contract to William McLees, AIA, of the firm of William McLees Architecture; and

WHEREAS, under the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq., the subject contract would be a contract for professional services because:

1. Professional services of the type herein sought are of such a nature as to require a high degree to trust and confidence in the individual providing the service and may require the creation of a confidential or fiduciary relationship between that individual and the Borough;
2. The services required are highly specialized or technical in nature;
3. The services require peculiar ability and skill, and demand a high degree of specialized knowledge or expertise;
4. The services are such that their relative worth must be judged by subjective considerations that are not susceptible of valuation by competitive bidding;
5. The individual or entity who will provide these services has demonstrated competence and particular expertise in the services required;
6. The individual or entity who will perform these services is held to and fully adheres to the strict ethical standards that govern the involved profession;
7. The services include advise to and consultation with the municipality that require both knowledge and judgment on the part of the individual or entity providing services, as well as the confidence of the municipal officials, such that competitive bidding is not feasible or practical;

8. The services to be provided are such that their nature, scope and duration are not capable of precise measurement, but rather require a flexibility and discretion that render competitive bidding impractical and inefficient; and

CORRESPONDENCE:

-**THANK YOU** to Ocean View Vet Hospital and Cape May Vets – excessive number of injured birds in WC. Mayor Cabrera thanked both Ocean View Vet Hospital and Cape May Vets on the record for their efforts with the injured birds. The Governing Body reminded everyone to be cognizant of the birds.

-**Dogs on the beach** – There have been many complaints about dogs on the beach. Dogs are prohibited on the beaches from May through September and the ordinance needs stricter enforcement.

-**Charging Station** (potentially at old library) – There have been several suggestions to have a charging station for electric cars in the borough. The commissioners have decided to give the idea to the Green Team and will await their recommendations.

-**Smoking on the beach** (many complaints) – The commissioners have been receiving several emails about smoking on the beach. They agreed that better signage was needed and they discussed ways to better enforce the area where smoking is not prohibited. They referenced Resolution No. 9 urging the Governor to provide funding for enforcement so the burden of labor and money don't fall on the shoulders of the local taxpayers.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Louise Wilson, 119 W. Denver Road, suggested allowing smoking back by the trashcans so as to not add confusion where it is allowed. The Chief of Police pointed out that is not suggested due to trash can fires and that a designated area is a contained area.

Jack Forbes, 9302 New Jersey Avenue, indicated that his home is adjacent to the field next to our Public Works field. He further indicated that Crest Memorial School has moved their soccer nets over to that field (due to construction at the CMS field) and that there are kids that kick balls onto his property and that the area is a dust bowl. The Administrator added that there is a lease agreement with the school effective September 1st and that the field will be locked at that point and if there are kids using it, it is not an organized school event. The Mayor added that the construction taking place with the school yard is their project, not the Borough's. He asked that the Administrator reach out to the Superintendent and to work with the school to address these issues. The Mayor suggested manipulating the equipment or having it removed and asked for a little patience so the issues can be properly channeled and addressed.

Louise Wilson, 119 W. Denver Road, brought up several more suggestions:

-Handicapped Parking on Toledo Avenue on the beach block: Commissioner Thompson indicated that this was already being addressed.

-Beach Boxes on every street for year 2020: The Mayor indicated that we will re-examine next year.

-North Wildwood allows golf carts along beach near bulkhead before dunes and if the Crest will consider it: The Mayor indicated our Engineer was working on a permit and it was a possibility.

-Second Home Owner Committee: The Mayor added it was on an agenda at one point but opted to hold off for the time being with the number of recently appointed committees. He welcomed suggestions at any borough meeting or via email.

-Kayak launch area: perhaps to add a winch for aiding bigger kayaks. The Mayor added that the dock was made by EZ Dock and perhaps there is an add on for it.

Jack Forbes, 9302 New Jersey Avenue, suggested adding the “no smoking” sign behind the lifeguard stands for all to see. He was informed that signs were already on order.

Chief McGrath, WCPD, thanked everyone for their efforts and assistance for National Night Out and it was a huge success.

DISCUSSION:

NEW BUSINESS:

-Sunset Lake Bathroom: The Mayor asked the commissioners to consider seasonal bathrooms along sunset lake in next year’s budget. They agreed there is a need for more accessible bathrooms if the yacht club is not available.

OLD BUSINESS:

-Donation of Sick Time- Still waiting for word from Civil Service before any further movement can be done. Once received back, a resolution will be forthcoming and the Policies & Procedures Manual will be amended.

-Washington Avenue Lot/Field: The Mayor asked the governing body to consider what the Borough would like to do with the lot after the agreement with the school expires.

-Construction Sites Ord. Amendments: There is a draft ordinance being circulated and awaiting comments.

-Parking for RVs – There is a draft ordinance in circulation.

-Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance Amendments (Sunset Lake Area) There is a draft ordinance in circulation to address parking regulations

-Old Library- Commissioner Thompson indicated that parking at the concerts seems to be an issue and perhaps the use of the lot at Lotus Road could be used. The Mayor added that there was originally parking there a while back and the residents were upset looking at a parking lot and secondly, the Borough was the recipient of Open Space funds along that area for the playground and equipment the plans and the plans need to be examined carefully.

-Faux Lawn- It was discovered that the faux lawn can be used anywhere a non-pervious cover can go. The commissioners agreed to let the Green Team provide comments and feed back and then perhaps to the Planning Board.

-Ordinance Change Ch. 79 speed limits and No Turn on Red- There is a draft ordinance being circulated and awaiting comments.

-Referendum permitting one consumption liquor license in business zone- No movement.

-Vacancy on the Green Team / PLANNING BOARD

There was interest in the Planning Board and the commissioners agreed to appoint at the next meeting and asked that that Green Team vacancy be pulled as it is an advisory board.

-Cross Walks on Atlantic Avenue- The Mayor pointed out they are receiving many emails about the speed along Atlantic Avenue and cars going around when someone stops to let a pedestrian cross.

Mr. Froyer, 207 E. Palm Road, added that SUVs crossing streets often block sight and maybe lowering the speed limit would help. The Mayor added that safety is paramount and the issue must be examined.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

The Mayor once again opened the floor for public commentary.

Louis Wilson, 119 W. Denver Road, added that parking is desperately needed when you offer concerts and events. The Mayor added that when they consider new parks, parking will be taken into consideration.
