

**BOROUGH OF WILDWOOD CREST  
GREEN TEAM  
Meeting Minutes – 30 January 2019  
Borough Hall, 6101 Pacific Avenue**

The Borough of Wildwood Crest Green Team met on 30 January 2019 in the Second Floor Conference Room.

The meeting came to order at 2 p.m.

Chairman Wilson read the "Sunshine Act" and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Sam Wilson, Gene Mulligan, Angel Daniels, Joe Franco, Deborah Rogers, and John Livecchi were in attendance. A quorum was declared.

The minutes of the meeting 28 November were approved on motion of Ms. Daniels, second by Mr. Franco and unanimous voice vote.

This was the annual reorganization meeting. Ms. Daniels moved to re-elect the existing slate of Officers: Sam Wilson, Chairman; Gene Mulligan, Vice-Chairman; Deborah Rogers, Secretary. Mr. Franco provided the second. Officers re-elected by unanimous voice vote.

Mr. Franco moved to approve the proposed calendar (attached hereto and made part hereof) of meeting dates. Mr. Livecchi provided the second. Calendar approved by unanimous voice vote.

Under Correspondence, the Secretary brought the recent Sustainable Jersey newsletters to the attention of the Team and reminded the Team of the importance of participating in upcoming webinars. The Clean Energy proposals for Borough-owned properties have been distributed to the Team. The Team endorsed the proposals, noting the possibility of points through Sustainable Jersey for endorsing and encouraging these actions.

Under Old Business Mr. Franco reported Brian Cuniff, Borough Public Relations Representative, has been posting Team activities on the Borough web page and accounts and encouraged input from Team members.

Mr. Franco said he has had continued contact with Micky McLaughlin and is trying to establish a date when he can make a presentation to the Team about electric car charging stations. He shared the location of several stations installed by Mr. McLaughlin encouraging Team members to visit these.

Mr. Franco reported Commissioner Thompson would like the solar subcommittee to meet with him and an engineer at the Von Savage Pool to discuss the proposed solar installation there.

Mr. Mulligan reported on the NJ Tree Foundation seminar he attended on 7 December. He distributed various materials referencing tree planting and pests. Mr. Mulligan shared a draft letter to the Board of Commissioners requesting DPW participation in the seminars as this is a requirement of Sustainable Jersey and the CFMP. He said Lisa Simms is available to speak at a meeting, and he will pursue booking her for July or August.

The secretary reported she has been in contact with Mrs. Celebre and the Wellness Committee to put together a smoking abatement presentation. It is suggested that this be done at the Wellness Fair in June. It was also noted the Board of Commissioners has adopted a Health and Wellness Policy for the Borough.

Under new business, the Team continued the matter of plastic bags, drinking straws and balloons noting changes in the use of these items. Mrs. Celebre emailed photographs from an ocean clean-up and awareness event she attended showing timelines of biodegradation timetables for various types of pollution.

Mr. Mulligan said he had researched and will provide portable ashtrays which could be included in future displays as an alternative to throwing cigarette butts on the ground.

No members of the public spoke.

The Team will meet on 27 February 2019 at 2 p.m.

Meeting adjourned on motion of Ms. Daniels, second by Mr. Livecchi and unanimous vote at 2:55 p.m.
