Zach Ruffo made a motion to accept the minutes from the last Recreation Commission meeting in March. Toni Fuscellaro seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

Brian Cunniff asked the members if they had received the recent email about the proposals for upgraded playground equipment and additional plans for Scoop Taylor and sunrise parks. Toni Fuscellaro and Zach Ruffo both said they had received them. Plans include new playground equipment at Scoop Taylor, additional playground equipment at Sunrise and exercise stations at Sunrise.

Zach Ruffo asked what happens to the old playground equipment. Frank Basile stated he believes it is removed the destroyed but is not positive.

Frank Basile said there was discussion about water-based play equipment but consensus during discussion was that those things don't work here. Could get too many people using them to wash sand off feet after coming off beach. Also very labor intensive with upkeep and expensive.

Frank Basile said the thought is that many people on bikes on the bike path may stop and use exercise stations. More bike racks included.

Toni Fuscellaro asked what kind of surface the new playground at Sunrise would have.

Frank stated it would be a padded surface that is ADA accessible.

Frank Basile stated that additional basketball courts and a bocce ball court, as well as lighting, were discussed for Sunrise but did not make it to the final plans.

Frank Basile stated that returning campers for Pier Playmates Day Camp have been sending in their registration forms and payment. Open registration for the camp begins April 27.

Frank Basile stated that summer basketball registration is open. Deadline is mid June.

Brian Cunniff reminded the members that financial disclosure forms for 2018 can now be filled out online.
