Wildwood Crest to host Flag Day ceremony June 12 as part of 250th celebrations

WILDWOOD CREST – The Borough of Wildwood Crest is set to host a Flag Day ceremony on Friday, June 12, at 10 a.m. at the gazebo at Sunset Lake near Bayview Drive and Miami Avenue as part of the borough’s 250th celebrations.

Numerous borough officials and students from Crest Memorial School will take part in the event, which is being held in advance of the national celebration of Flag Day on June 14.

As part of the June 12 ceremony, an American flag will be formally raised for the first time on a flagpole recently erected next to the Sunset Lake gazebo. In addition, Crest Memorial students will bury a time capsule filled with current artifacts at the base of the flagpole.

The public is encouraged to attend the event.

The June 12 Flag Day ceremony is one of several events planned by the Borough of Wildwood Crest in conjunction with its celebrations surrounding the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Other events include a free patriotic art class at the Crest Arts Pavilion on June 22, a lecture on the Battle of Turtle Gut Inlet at the Crest Arts Pavilion on June 23, a Reenactment of the Battle of Turtle Gut Inlet at Sunset Lake on June 28, a Patriotic Drone Show at Sunset Lake on June 29, a patriotic baby parade at Centennial Park on July 1, a live reading of the Declaration of Independence ahead of live music by the Legacy Band at Centennial Park on July 4 and more. The borough previously hosted a stage performance of “Margaret’s Diary During A Revolution” on June 5 at the Crest Arts Pavilion.
