## **Wildwood Crest Pier Recreation Center to open for residents Oct. 5**

WILDWOOD CREST – The Wildwood Crest Pier Recreation Center is set to reopen to the public Monday, Oct. 5, after being closed for open recreation since March due to governor's orders with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Access to the Crest Pier Recreation Center will be limited to Wildwood Crest residents only and to no more than 25 people at one time until further notice. Proof of residency will be required. All patrons will be required to wear masks and follow proper social-distancing guidelines as much as possible while partaking in any activity inside the Crest Pier Recreation Center.

Crest Recreation will provide hand sanitizing stations in multiple areas throughout the building and will encourage frequent use of same by patrons.

All patrons must fill out an Acknowledgment Waiver form prior to the first time they enter the building. Parents of children under the age of 18 will be required to fill out same on behalf of their child/children. The waiver will be kept on file through June 2021.

All patrons will have temperatures checked immediately upon entering the building near the front desk. Readings will be logged by Crest Recreation staff. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 or greater and/or exhibiting other signs of illness at any time will be required to exit the facility immediately, unless that patron is under the age 18. Children under the age of 18 with a fever of 100.4 or greater and/or exhibiting other signs of illness at any time will be isolated immediately. A parent/guardian will be contacted and instructed to pick the child up immediately. Illness reporting guidelines set forth by the New Jersey Department of Health will be followed, including contact tracing if applicable. Those required to exit the facility due to high temperatures/signs of illness will be required to provide a doctor's note prior to being permitted to enter the facility.

All patrons using the fitness room must fill out a new Fitness Room Registration Form and Acknowledgment Waiver form prior to first use. Upon receipt of those forms, Crest

Recreation will provide a form that will be required to use to sign in for each subsequent visit. Forms will remain on file through June 2021.

Fitness room capacity at this time will be limited to no more than three people at any one time. Equipment will be spaced in a manner that promotes social distancing. Patrons will be required to maintain social distancing as much as possible while using the fitness room.

Any patron wishing to use the fitness room should register in advance. Appointments will be available each hour. Fitness room usage will be limited to 50 minutes per person, allowing for 10 minutes of sanitation time.

Patrons will be required to thoroughly clean any equipment with which they come in contact following use. Crest Recreation staff will also clean equipment again after each patron leaves the room.

Crest Pier Recreation Center open recreation times for October are as follows:

Monday-Friday: Adults 9:30 a.m.-3 p.m. and 7-9 p.m.; grammar school children 3-7 p.m.; high school children 6-9 p.m. (Note: building closes at 8 pm on Friday evenings.)

Saturday: Grammar school children 11 a.m.-3 p.m.; high school children 2-5 p.m.; adults 3-5 p.m.

Crest Pier Fitness Room hours for October are Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

All open recreation hours and fitness room hours are subject to change due to scheduled programs and activities.
