Wildwood Crest and Wildwood Offer Continued Support for a Dune Replenishment and Expansion Project that Benefits the Citizens of All Wildwood Municipalities

WILDWOOD CREST – On November 7, 2025, the U.S. Army Corps. of Engineers (USACE) and the N.J. Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) notified the mayors of the City of North Wildwood, the City of Wildwood, the Borough of Wildwood Crest, and the Township of Lower that work on the existing form of the Hereford Inlet to Cape May Inlet Coastal Project has been suspended indefinitely. USACE and NJDEP have communicated their intent to instead put resources into evaluating an alternative approach to the dune replenishment and expansion project utilizing offshore sand sources. Wildwood Crest and Wildwood support that effort and offer their continued cooperation towards a project that benefits all citizens of the Wildwood municipalities.

Throughout this process, Wildwood Crest and Wildwood have remained steadfast in (1) their commitment to the interests of their own citizens, (2) their need to maintain their own beaches and dunes, and (3) their desire to provide aid to their neighbor: North Wildwood. Wildwood Crest and Wildwood reaffirm their commitment to working hand-in-hand with North Wildwood towards a new and better form of the project.
