Construction work on two Wildwood Crest streets to conclude by June 30

WILDWOOD CREST – Street reconstruction work on the 100 East blocks of Farragut Road and Miami Avenue in the Borough of Wildwood Crest is set to be complete no later than June 30, the borough has announced.

This work is part of a larger comprehensive street construction project along Pacific Avenue south of Rambler Road and a number of side streets by Asphalt Paving Systems Inc. that includes improvements to water mains, sewer lines, storm sewers and street surfacing.

All work on this project was due to be suspended by June 15 in advance of the busy summer season. However, that deadline has been extended to allow for topcoat paving of Farragut Road and Miami Avenue in order to make the street surfaces as safe as possible as quickly as possible.

Work on this project began last fall. Once topcoat paving of these streets is complete, all work will be suspended for the months of July and August. Work will recommence in the fall and is expected to be complete by the spring of 2021.

In addition, in conjunction with this project, South Jersey Gas plans to install residential gas lines and abandon the old gas main along the 100 East block of Farragut Road prior to street paving. South Jersey Gas has requested that all residents in this block that have not already done so to contact them immediately to arrange for connection.
