## **Crest Arts Pavilion to host presentation on history of women's suffrage in New Jersey Oct. 4**

WILDWOOD CREST – The Borough of Wildwood Crest will host a presentation on the history of women's suffrage in New Jersey on Friday, Oct. 4, at 10 a.m. at the Crest Arts Pavilion, located at 6301 Ocean Avenue. The event is free to the public and no registration is necessary.

The presentation will focus on New Jersey women, some local, who fought for the voting rights of women in the 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries prior to the passage of the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment in 1920 and their legacy that endures to this day.

The program will be presented by Pary Tell, who served as the Director/Curator of the Museum of Cape May County for seven years before becoming the Director of the Division of Culture & Heritage for Cape May County. Now retired, she has a particular interest in telling the stories of women in our history that have often been overlooked. She currently serves as the Treasurer of the League of Historical Societies of New Jersey, chairs the Lower Township Historic Preservation Commission and is president of Preserving the Wildwoods, A Community Alliance.
