Chairman Sam Wilson called the Borough of Wildwood Crest Green Team to order at 1pm

Chairman Wilson read the "Sunshine Act" and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Administrator Mahon continued by advising the team the Borough is looking to Crest Pier and the Von Savage Pool as locations for upcoming EV charging stations. Member MacQueen let the team know they have achieved 165 pts for the SJ Matrix and will be putting in the application by the late May deadline. She encouraged others to submit more duties to bump up points. Member Diessroth updated the team on the Turtle Sub-Committee meeting. They will be asking the Borough Police Department for electric signs reminding the public of local turtle crossings and to be aware of speed. He suggested information boxes to be placed around town to educate folks. Team suggested Scoop Taylor Park and Sunset Lake. Member Celebre, speaking of Blue Flag program, has asked for a meeting on Wednesday May 11 to have a group discussion about moving forward with Blue Flag.
