**Meeting Minutes January 28, 2026

The Team discussed the future of the Atlantic Ave tree planting and fully supports the enhancement of the borough. The team discussed collaborating with the Creative Arts Council in creating a recycled beach toy box for the summer. This will help with littering along our beaches and teach children about recycling at the beach.
