

**BOROUGH OF WILDWOOD CREST
GREEN TEAM
Meeting Minutes – 28 November 2018
Borough Hall, 6101 Pacific Avenue**

The Borough of Wildwood Crest Green Team met on 28 November 2018 in the Second Floor Conference Room.

The meeting came to order at 2 p.m.

Chairman Wilson read the "Sunshine Act" and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Sam Wilson, Gene Mulligan, Angel Daniels, Joe Franco, Deborah Rogers, Darleen Devlin and John Livecchi were in attendance. A quorum was declared.

The minutes of the meeting 24 October were approved on motion of Mr. Franco, second by Ms. Daniels and unanimous voice vote with Mr. Mulligan and Mr. Wilson abstaining.

Mrs. Devlin left the meeting at 2:05 p.m.

Under Correspondence, the Secretary brought the recent Sustainable Jersey newsletter to the attention of the Team and reminded the Team of the upcoming workshop luncheon and registration deadlines. Mr. Mulligan will be attending the seminar 7 Dec and said there are possibly two DPW employees who will attend.

Under Old Business Mr. Franco reported Brian Cuniff, Borough Public Relations Representative, has been posting Team activities on the Borough accounts and encouraged input from Team members.

Mrs. Rogers reported the draft budget for 2019 is included in the CFMP from Peter Lomax, however, the Chairman noted discrepancies. The Team voted to accept the budget with amendments to remedy the discrepancies.

The secretary will contact Peter Lomax regarding the annual report.

Mr. Franco reported that he has talked to Commissioner Thompson about the proposed solar array installation on Borough Hall. Mr. Thompson has requested a meeting with the subcommittee.

Under new business, the Team continued the matter of plastic bags, drinking straws and balloons noting changes in the use of these items.

The Secretary also informed the Team of Planning Board action underway for the rehabilitation of the NJ Ave Business district and pointed out a recommended change to the Land Use Ordinance that would prohibit shops selling vaping products or paraphernalia in the B-1 Zone.

The regular meeting scheduled for 26 December was canceled by unanimous voice vote.

No members of the public spoke.

The Team will meet on 23 January 2019 at 2 p.m.
