All meetings, including those held with communications equipment, must be noticed in a manner consistent with the requirements of the Act, unless the meeting is for emergent circumstances and held in a manner consistent with the requirements set forth at N.J.S.A. 10:4-9(b).

The options for the January 6, 2021 Commission Meeting at 9:30 a.m.:

- 1. In accordance with Executive Order No. 196, there is a cap for indoor small gatherings, which is 25% of the capacity, not to exceed 100 people. The Commissioners' meeting room has an occupancy load of 95; therefore, no more than 24 people may be in the room. If /when the meeting reaches 24 people, it will then be closed, but it can still be streamed.


