**ORDINANCE NO. 1473**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 56, OF  
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WILDWOOD CREST, ENTITLED  
RECREATION COMMISSION, SECTION 56-1, COMMISSION CREATION,  
APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Wildwood Crest have determined that it is necessary and proper, for health, benefit and welfare of the community, to amend the composition of the Recreation Commission pursuant to their authority as stated in Chapter 56-1, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners have reviewed the current ordinance and are desirous of amending the composition from three members to five members and approving the same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Wildwood Crest, County of Cape May, New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** The portion of Ordinance 608, adopted July 10, 1985, and the portion of Ordinance 926 adopted on February 12, 2003 and the Section of 56-1 of Chapter 56, Recreation Commission, of the Borough Code of the Borough of Wildwood Crest is hereby amended as follows (added language is underlined, deleted language is ~~stricken~~):

**§ 56-1. Commission Creation, Appointment of Members.**

There is hereby created, authorized and established a Board of Commissioners, to be known as the "Recreation Commission," which said Commission shall consist of ~~three (3)~~ five (5) members who shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioner of the Borough for staggered three (3) year terms from January 1 of the year of their appointment.


**Section 2.** The remainder of all other sections and subsections of the aforementioned ordinance not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** All other ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


**Section 4.** If any portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.


**Section 5.** This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after final passage and advertisement thereof as required by law.
