Brian Cunniff stated that the work at Scoop Taylor Park is complete, except for the installation of the gazebo/shade structure, which should be installed sometime in the new year. He added that the park is already getting a lot of activity.

Tore Volpe asked if the swings are new as well. Brian replied that they are.

Brian Cunniff stated that the tryouts for the South Shore Basketball teams are ongoing. Looks like the Islander program will have two teams at the grades 5-6 level and one team each at the grades 3-4 and grades 7-8 levels. Brian added that the Scoop Taylor Tip-Off Classic basketball tournament is scheduled for Dec. 9-19 and that teams have already been reaching out about participating.

Brian Cunniff stated that the hip-hop dance aerobics class is being held Mondays at 5 pm. Participation has been OK. Hoping to improve. He added that the Zumba class on Saturdays had good attendance the first couple of weeks but that there has been a major decline since. The program will end right before Thanksgiving. Might try it again after the Christmas holidays.

A recreation department staff member, Jim Foglia, is setting up a massive train display for the holidays in the Crest Pier main lobby. All of the equipment is his own and most of his setup is being done on his own time.

The Crest Pier fitness room will be open one hour earlier at 8:30 am Monday through Saturday going forward beginning in December on a trial basis. If people are utilizing this extra early hour the plan is to make it a permanent change.
